Daily Grooming Reports

The Beaver Creek Mountain grooming report is posted each morning on the internet at www.beavercreek.com.

Grooming and trail information is also displayed at the top of most lifts and on resort information monitors. A printed grooming and resort information map is available to pick up at most lodge front desks, at the Resort Information Center and is passed out by Mountain Guest Service Staff (dressed in red jackets). You may call (970) 754-5950 for a recording of the grooming report and (970) 754-4888 for the snow report or watch KVBA TV8 for updates each morning.

Thursday Night Lights (970) 754-4636

A glowstick ski-down to music with a fireworks display afterwards. Guests may participate in the actual ski-down if they are level 5 (intermediate) skier/rider or above. Poles are not necessary. Held Thursdays, late December into March.

To Participate register at 5:30pm** at the Beaver Creek Children's Ski School located at the base of the Buckaroo Express Gondola next to McCoy's Café. ALL participants must sign a waiver. Ages 17 and under must have a waiver signed by an adult/guardian.

To Watch be at the bottom of the Buckaroo Express Gondola shortly after 6:00pm.
