Core Area Tent Guidelines

(Adopted November 10, 1999)

(Revised August 17, 2000)

Strawberry Park / Chair 12
Golf Course
Creekside Park
East & West Parking Lots

BEAVER CREEK PLAZA:

Ice Rink: Permanent Summer Cover under study

Temporary Tent: Grandfathered for Culinary events. Requires BCRC BOD approval for any other functions. (See “Variance Process”)

Color: White only

Height: No higher than 20’

Event Tents: Size: 20’ x 20’ maximum

Color: White only

Locations: To be identified on Plaza Map, approved by staff

Maximum time: Five days, including set-up and tear-down, no more than 10 days within any 30 day period

Approvals: BCRC staff

Tye-downs: BCRC staff approval required

Snowmelt system: If damaged, vendor will be charged for any necessary repairs

STRAWBERRY PARK:

Summer: Size: 20’ x 20’ maximum

Color: White only

Locations: To be identified on site map

Maximum time: Five days, including set-up and tear-down, no more than 10 days within any 30 day period

Approvals: BCRC staff

Winter: Size: 20’ x 60’ maximum, with support tent

Color: White only

Location: To be approved by BCRC staff and Mountain staff

Maximum time: Five days, including set-up and tear-down

Approvals: BCRC staff and Mountain staff

GOLF COURSE:

Permanent Members Tent: At halfway house, 20' x 20'

Event Tents: 40' x 80' maximum, one only per function, with related cooking tent, and up to ten 10'x10' tents on the course

Color: White or clear

Maximum time: Five days, including set-up and tear-down

Approvals: BCRC staff

CREEKSIDE PARK:

Summer only: Size: 40' x 80' maximum, one only per function, with related cooking tent and up to five 10'x10' tents

Color: White only

Location: To be approved by BCRC staff and Village Operations staff

Maximum time: Five days, including set-up and tear-down

Approvals: BCRC staff and Village Operations staff

EAST & WEST PARKING LOTS:

Based on the long lead nature of any events which might require the use of tents on the East or West parking lots, it is suggested that any request for the use of tents is submitted simultaneously to the Beaver Creek Resort Company and the Beaver Creek Design Review Board three months prior to the event for consideration.

II. Variance Process: If a tent request does not comply with the tent guidelines, a variance from the guidelines shall be submitted to the Beaver Creek Design Review staff. The request will be reviewed within (3) three business days; Design Review staff recommendation will then be submitted to the Beaver Creek Resort Company Board of Directors for final resolution within (5) five business days, if the proposed tent:

- Is a compelling benefit to the membership of the resort and/or;
- Serves as a national, international or world-class championship event, and/or;
- Is a nationally or internationally televised event, and/or;
- Attracts and exposes the Beaver Creek Resort to significant national or international media exposure.
